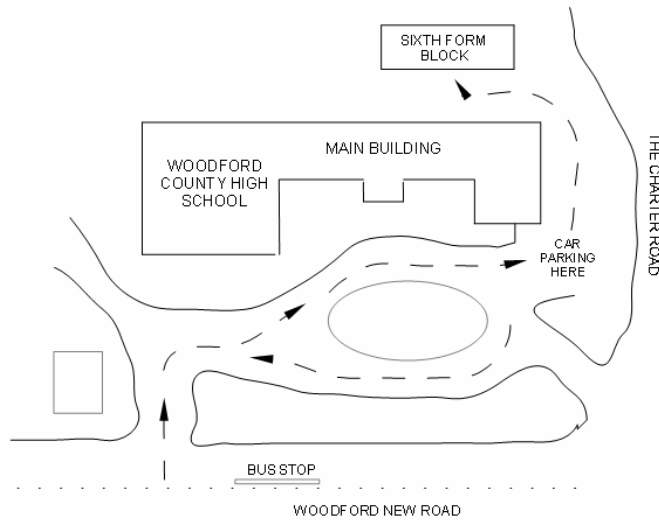


WEST ESSEX ARCHAEOLOGICAL GROUP
GUIDE FOR VISITORS TO OUR MONTHLY LECTURES

Our monthly lecture meetings are held in the Sixth Form block at the rear of Woodford County High School, High Road, Woodford Green IG8 9LA. The school is indicated by the pointer on the map below.



To get to the Sixth Form block enter the grounds of the school at the main gate then walk past the front of the school, to the far end of the car park, then turn left and follow the narrow path between the wall of the building and the fence towards the rear of the building – the block is in front of you across a tarmac playground and down a set of steps.

The annual Rudge lectures are held in the School Hall – enter the school grounds at the main gate and follow the road towards the car park, the Hall is the first large building in front of you.

The school is near to Woodford station on the Central Line – please remember to take a train to Epping, Loughton or Debden in the East-bound direction, then walk up Snakes Lane West and then left along the High Road, cross at the lights and the entrance to the school is just beyond the bus stop.

Please note that this route is just under 1 mile and is uphill, so will take at least 20 minutes. Taxis are available from the station (lifts can be arranged for speakers if required – see below).

The school is served by bus routes 20, 179 & W13 (stop outside the school) and 275 (stops at the top of Broadmead Road).
